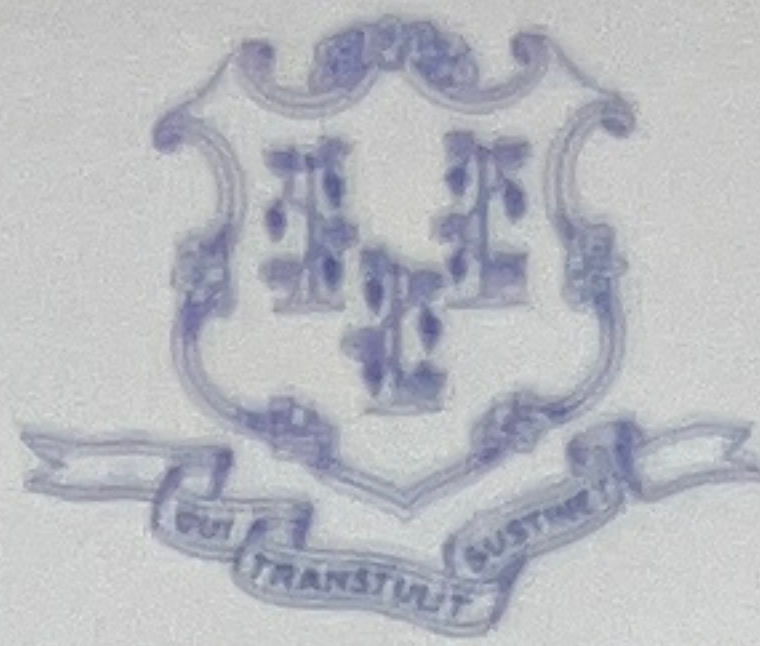

As stated in my letter dated September 8, 2026, I reviewed your previous communications and it appears that the requests outlined in your email dated July 12, 2026, remain outstanding. In response thereto, please be advised as follows:

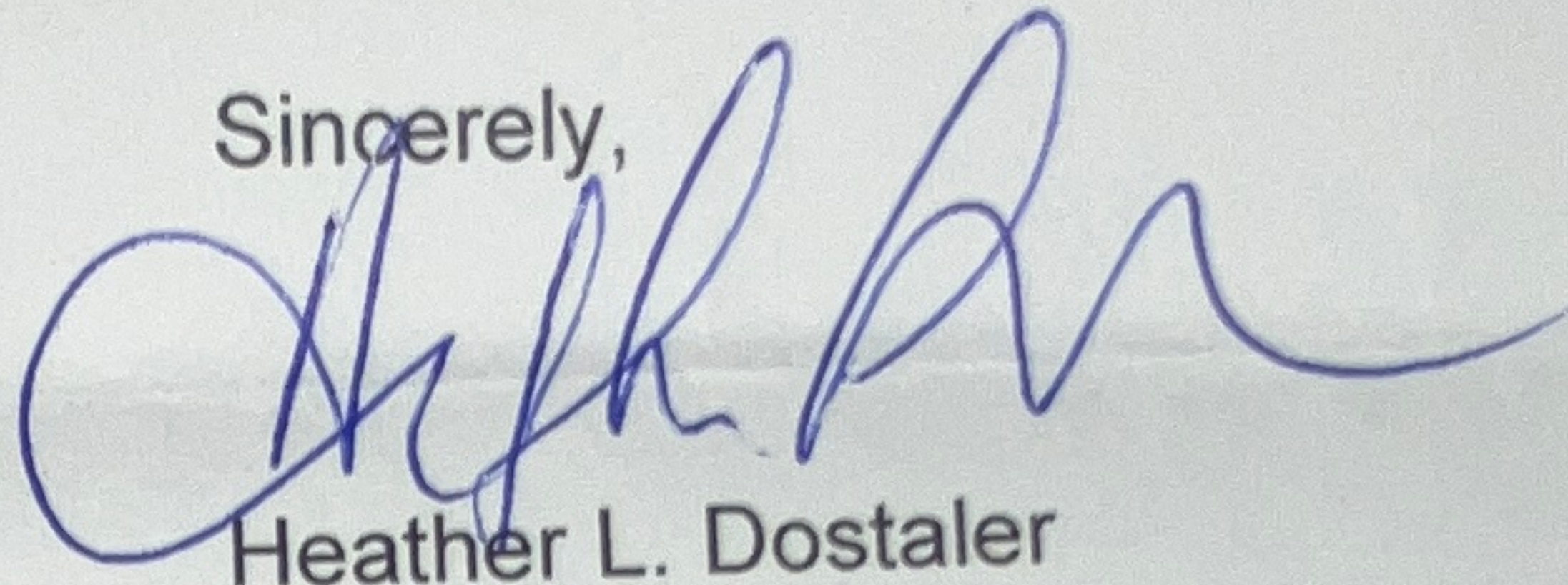
- Data from 2022 on petitions for electroshock therapy broken down between with a conservator and without a conservator. The Office of the Probate Court Administrator does not maintain data in this form.
- Petitions for electroshock therapy for 2025. The Office of the Probate Court Administrator furnished data for January through June of 2025 on September 8, 2025 and July through December 2025 on August 27, 2026.
- Petitions to Consent to Psychiatric Medication Treatment pursuant to C.G.S. § 17a-543(e) for 2012 to 2025 [fiscal years] by court. See attached.
- Verification of the accuracy of the initially provided petitions for electroshock therapy data from 2012-2024. The data speaks for itself.

While the Office of the Probate Court Administrator is a public agency, it is an administrative office that supports the operations of the Probate Courts of the State of Connecticut.
